**PEACHES TO THE BEACHES AND MARY ROSS WATERFRONT PARK
RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Applicants must have submitted the application and provided the necessary funds to be on the list for space allocation. Payment is due upon receipt of application. Failure to set up at the Park on the assigned day will result in forfeiture of booth fee.
2. Hours are 8 AM to 5 PM. Vendors must be set up for business by 8 AM and remain open until 5 PM unless weather is prohibitive or sold out of merchandise. Rain does not cancel.
3. The appearance of your booth must be kept neat. Display units and decorations such as balloons, banners, signs, etc. may be used but must be secured with tape or rope. **NO NAILS MAY BE DRIVEN INTO ANY STRUCTURE.** Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents and displays.
4. Yard Sale/Flea Market items are limited to nick-knacks, odds & ends, furniture, dishes, household items, etc. The sale of used clothing is not permitted. Also, no objectionable messages/symbols on clothing items or signage, explicit objects or paraphernalia will be displayed or offered for sale in the space during this event. Security of the items in the space allocated to me or my organization is not the responsibility of the organizers or volunteers of this event.
5. No clothing or other items bearing the official PEACHES TO THE BEACHES YARD SALE logo are to be produced or sold at this event.
6. Vehicles will not be allowed on the sidewalks or lawn after 8 AM or before 4 PM to ensure pedestrian access and safety. Vendors arriving late or leaving early will be required to load/unload from public parking areas only.
7. Booth space is to be cleaned and all debris placed in containers provided or removed from premises by vendor. No items can remain at the close of the Bazaar. Vendors will be fined a minimum of \$25, if items are not removed or thrown away.
8. Management reserves the right to refuse any incompatible or inappropriate goods from being sold, and may request the booth be closed for the duration of the Sale.
9. No alcoholic beverages allowed. No pets allowed.
